12. Content of First Information Report

I am posted at Police Station Jehangirabad as Station Incharge. Today on 03/12/2011 I reached Raisen Road near Barkhedhi Railway Crossing with riot drill equipment and tear gas and arms and ammunition with Sub Inspector M P Mourya, Assistant Sub Inspector S N Dube, Head Constable Badge No. 2315 Shailendra Singh and Head Constable Badge No. 1950 Mahendra

Singh and Head Constable Badge No. 1844 Vijendra Nigam, Constable Badge No. 2239 Shivkumar Tiwari, Constable Badge No. 843 Nand Kishore Dube, Constable Badge No. 2839 Sanjay Tomar, Constable Badge No. 545 Mohd. Tariq, Constable Badge No. 1342 Arvind Shukla, Constable Badge No. 191 Premnarayan on government vehicle no. MP-03-6879 for law and order duty during rail roko agitation by Bhopal gas victims organizations. Senior Superintendent of Police Shri Yogesh Chaudhary, Collector Shri Nikunj Shrivastav, Additional Police Superintendent Zone 1 Shri Rajesh Chandel, Zone 2 Shri Manohar Verma and Zone 5 Shrimati Monika Shukla, Sub Divisional Magistrate Shri G S Dhurve, Sub Divisional Magistrate Shri Umashankar Bhargav and Senior Police Officials as per attached list, Executive Magistrate, City Police Superintendent, Police Station Incharge and force from Special Task Force and police women reached the scene for maintenance of law and order where 1. under Shri Balkrishna Namdeo's leadership, 2. Navin Jain R/o Barkhedhi, 3. Mohsin R/o Aishbag, 4. Parvez R/o Aishbag, 5. Naved Ali R/o Kabitpura, 6. Faiz Khan R/o Bag Umrao, Bhopal, 7. Rizwan R/o Chhawani, Mangalwara, 8. Md. Afzal, R/o Itwara, Bhopal, 9. Amir R/o Jehangirabad, Bhopal, 10. Bhagwati Bai, 11. Laxmi Devi, 12. Rasida Bee, 13. Champa Devi Shukla, 14. Nawab Khan, 15. Safreen Khan, 16. Anis Qureshi, 17. Rampyari Bai, 18. Sahid Bhai, 19. Safiq Khan, 20. Abdul Bhai, 21. Sultan Bee, 22. Sanoor Bee R/o Bag Umrao Dulha, Aishbag, Bhopal, 23. Batul Bee R/o Ahata Sikandar Coolie, 24. Naresh Vishwakarma and others between 1500-2000 men and women together with one understanding became very violent on the railway track near the railway crossing and started abusing and shouting slogans and stood on the railway tracks from Barkhedhi crossing to Para over bridge. Then senior officials and the executive magistrate tried to pacify the crowd and it was announced on the loud haler that the agitation was illegal and people must move away from the tracks. Balkrishna Namdeo instigated the entire crowd and said nobody should move away from the tracks. He also asked people to throw rocks near the tracks at the police and chase them away. Then the entire crowd with the intention of killing started throwing stones on the police and at the executive magistrate. Then the goods train coming from Habibgang number KPB/SPL Down which contained inflammable sugar syrup was stopped by the crowd by keeping large rocks on the tracks and stopped movement of trains and tried to set the wagons containing inflammable sugar syrup on fire and started damaging railway property. Because the wagons contained explosive and inflammable material a serious incident could have been caused hence senior officials and executive magistrate once again announced on the loud haler and they were given much advice but the abovementioned accused ignored the advice and started heavy stone pelting with the intention of taking their lives. Several police officials, policemen and executive magistrate were very seriously injured. On the order of the executive magistrate and for self defence and protection of public property tear gas grenades were lobbed at the protestors but the protestors did not become quiet. Then Balkrishna Namdeo once again instigated the protestors and told them not to be afraid of tear gas and attack the police men and kill them. Then the

protestors became extremely violent and started shouting obscene abuses. They had swords with them, fire arms, sticks and with rocks by the side of the rail tracks they attacked with the intention of taking lives. On the order of the executive magistrate the police force applied light force through canes and sticks to disperse the protestors and control them but the protestors became even more violent and in order to kill fired from a country made gun and deliberately set fire to vehicles belonging to the police, executive magistrate and members of the public which lead to the following vehicles No MP-02-RD-0415, white color "Bolero" belonging to Sub Divisional Magistrate Shri Bhargav, MP-02-RD-0410, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Shri Dhurve, MP-04-CH-3028, "Chevrolet" belonging to press photographer Raj Patidar and motorcycle "Hero Honda" No MP- 04-NQ-6812 belonging to Arun Kumar, motorcycle "Pulsar" No MP-04-MD-2114 belonging to Shamim Khan, motorcycle "TVS Star Sports" No MP-04-MM-6840 Arvind Singh and motorcycle "Passion" No MP04-MS-6895 belonging to Vidya Sagar Sharma being destroyed and all government documents and other goods in those were also destroyed in fire and some vehicles and tyres were brought to the tracks and then set on fire and the bus belonging to Special Task Force No MP-03-5532 and Shri Jeeta-05 vehicle No MP-03-6894 and other government and private vehicles were damaged with stones and sticks and several officials and employees of the police including Senior Superintendent of Police, Shri Yogesh Chaudhary, Collector Shri Nikunj Shrivastava were attacked and were seriously injured and further the protestors went into Barkhedi basti damaging and setting fire and beating up common people and despite warning by the executive magistrate did not become quiet and then in self defence and to protect the property of the public as per the order of the executive magistrate the Special Task Force fired in the air and then the protestors came under control. If the firing in the air was not done much damage to lives and property could have occurred. Because of the attack by the protestors Senior Superintendent of Police 1. Shri Yogesh Chaudhary suffered injuries in his right leg, left leg and finger of right hand, Collector, 2. Shri Nikunj Shrivastav suffered injuries on the left side of his head, right knee and left leg, 3. Additional Police Superintendent, Shri Rajesh Chandel suffered injuries in his right leg, toes and big toe, 4. Shri Manohar Verma suffered injuries on his face, 5. Smt. Monica Shukla suffered injury on the right side of her stomach and concussion below her left knee and scratch on the back near the neck, 6. Sub Divisional Magistrate Shri G.S. Dhurve, 7. Shri Uma Shankar Bhargav suffered injuries in his finger of his right hand and palm of left hand, 8. Shri C.M. Mishra, 9. Tehsildar Shri Atul Singh, 10. City Superintendent of Police Shri Salim Khan suffered injuries in both legs, right thigh and left ankle, 11. Shri Ghanshyam Malviya suffered injuries to his teeth, 12. Shri H.N. Guru suffered injured injury to his finger of right hand, 13. Sub Inspector Kuldeep Khatri suffered injuries below his left knee, 14. Constable Surendra Mishra , 15. Shankarlal Sahu, 16. Constable Nandkishore Dubey, 17. Constable Rajesh Goyal, 18. Constable Ramlochan Ghoshi, 19. Deepesh Tomar, 20 Tek Bahadur, 21. Santosh Kumar, 22. Munneelal, 23 Pitam Singh, 24. Jitendra Sharma and several other officials and employees suffered severe injuries. The protestors attacked woman constable Parvathy with the intent of killing her that caused severe injury on her face and eye and she lost her vision and I too have suffered injuries on my right cheek and the calf of my right leg. On 2-12-11 the protestors were advised to carry out peaceful

protest with regard to their plan of Rail Roko at the Police Control Room by senior officials, despite that today protestors have become violent and angry and have caused destruction to railway and public property, obstructed government employees to carry out their duties, and attacked with the intent to kill causing severe injuries and used firearms and sharp edged weapons in order to kill and set government and private vehicles on fire and broke them causing damage. Most of the incident has been video graphed and the incidence has been witnessed by the police force and people walking by on the roads and residents of the basti. The IPC sections 307, 147, 148, 149, 341, 294, 353, 186, 332, 323, 435, 427, Sections under Railways Act, 150, 151, 174 and Sections under Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act No 3,4 were found to be relevant and the case has been made and is taken under investigation.
