12 **Content of First Information Report (FIR)**

1. I am posted as Sub-Inspector of Police Station, Aishbag. Today on 3.12.11 I went on law and order duty for the rail roko agitation by the gas victims organizations at Barkhedi, Aishbag Railway Crossing with Assistant Sub-Inspector Shyam Guru, RS Thakur, Md. Nazeer Khan, Chief Constable Gyan Singh Mewada, (Badge No 1654), Constable Vinay Dangi (Badge No 2159) with riot drill equipment and tear gas on government vehicle no MP 03 8059. There towards Barkhedi Railway Crossing, Senior Superintendent of Police, Shri Yogesh Chaudhary, Collector: Nikunj Shrivastava, Additional Police Superintendent Zone 1: Rajesh Singh Chandel, Additional Police Superintendent Zone 2: Shri Manohar Verma, Additional Police Superintendent Zone 5: Smt Monica Shukla, City Superintendent of Police: Shri Abdul Salim Khan, Police Station In charge, Police station Jehangirabad: P.N. Goyal, Sub Divisional Magistrate: G.S Dhurve, Sub Divisional Magistrate: Uma Shankar Bhargav and other Special Action Force, Government Railway Police and Railway Protection Force were on duty during which at 10:15 Balkrishna Namdeo leading a mass of protestors belonging to Bhopal gas victims organizations in which there were 1500-2000 women and men. All of them coming to common understanding came and stood in between the railway tracks and become violent and started shouting slogans containing obscene words against the government and administration. Senior officials at the location and the executive magistrate tried to pacify the protestors and on the loud haler announced that the protest was illegal and the protestors were told to move away from the tracks but Balkrishna Namdeo continued to instigate the crowd and said that no one should move from the railway tracks and he was saying pick up the stones next to the railway tracks and drive the police away by throwing them. Then the protestors became violent and started throwing rocks at the police force and the protestors ignored the advice of the senior officials and stopped a goods train that had tankers filled with inflammable substance coming from Habibganj and moving towards Bhopal station at about 10:30 AM. And Balkrishna Namdeo continued to instigate the crowd to throw rocks at the police. In response and by the order of the executive magistrate the police fired 3 tear gas grenades in self defence and to ensure security of public property. Despite this the protestors did not stop the violence and became more violent and set fire to government vehicles and motorcycles parked on the side of the road next to Barkhedi railway crossing and smashed the glass panes of mini bus no MP-04-H8893 and MP-04-H-8424 by throwing stones. In such a situation as per the order of the executive magistrate and senior police officials, light force was applied on the protestors and with much difficulty they were scattered and law and order was established. During this entire episode the following attackers in the protesting crowd 1.

Balkrishna Namdeo, 2 Tariq, 3 Md. Imran, 4 Md. Qamar, 5 Naeem Khan, 6 Pooran, 7 Mahesh Vishwakarma, 8 Shanu, 9 Aslam Theli, 10 Amjad, 11 Haseen, 12 Imran all resident of Aishbag police station area were recognized. Police officials on duty for maintenance of order at Aishbag crossing, City Superintendent of Police Govindpura division: Shri H.H. Guru, Assistant Sub Inspector Police Station Aishbag: R.S. Thakur, Head Constable 1654: Gyan Singh Mewada, Constable Vikram Bahadur from Police Line, Special Action Force Constable: Kamal, Gokul, Santosh, Rajesh, Women Constable: Divya Dubey and Journalists Arif, Sujit who were reporting received injuries on their hands legs head and other part of their bodies. The protestors have thrown rocks at the police and caused injury while they were maintaining law and order and have obstructed government work. In the stampede by the protestors and due to the rocks thrown at the police by them a few protestors have also received injuries. Iqbal, Shashikant Bhargav, Omprakash Patel present at the scene and the gateman on duty at Barkhedi railway crossing and other residents have seen and heard the incident and it has been videographed. If the protestors appear before me I can recognize them. This is the report on my return to the police station. Action may be taken.
